The Enforcement Committee of the Autorité des marchés financiers will soon publish press releases for each sanction decision

It can impose sanctions on any person or company whose practices contravene laws and regulations that fall within the jurisdiction of the AMF. And it takes part in the AMF's educational efforts by clarifying financial regulations when explaining its decisions.
