Summary of SPOT inspections on cybersecurity systems of asset management companies No. 2


As announced in the AMF's supervision priorities for 2020, the second series of SPOT inspections for 2020 targeting asset management companies consisted of a review of the cybersecurity systems of five companies. This campaign was supplemented by the findings noted during a conventional inspection. The work follows on from the inspections carried out on this topic in 2019. This further work was justified by the areas of risk identified during the first series of inspections (notably concerning the governance of cyber system and the incident management process), but also by a will to supplement the due diligence conducted by performing technical tests delegated to an accredited external third party.
