Withdrawal of registration of a digital asset service provider following the positive opinion of the *Autorité de Contrôle Prudentiel et de Résolution*

(Articles L.54-10-3 and D.54-10-5 III and IV of the Monetary and Financial Code)

OURO CAPITAL SAS

1. The French company OURO CAPITAL SAS was registered with the Créteil Trade and Companies Register under number 914 530 548 and as a digital asset service provider (“DASP”) on 7th March 2022, under number E2023-066 by the *Autorité des Marchés Financiers* (“AMF”) following the positive opinion of the *Autorité de Contrôle Prudentiel et de Résolution* (French Prudential Supervisory and Resolution Authority, “ACPR”), for the digital asset service referred in 3° (trading digital assets for other digital assets) of Article L. 54-10-2 of the Monetary and Financial Code.
2. Under the terms of Article L. 54-10-3 of the Monetary and Financial Code, the AMF may delist a DASP, with the positive opinion of the ACPR, at the request of the service provider.
3. By letter dated 18 February 2026, OURO CAPITAL SAS requested to be delisted as a DASP.
4. In accordance with Article D. 54-10-5 of the Monetary and Financial Code, as amended by decree No. 2023-787 of 17 August 2023, delisting takes effect upon expiry of a period determined by the AMF.
5. On 26 February 2026, the ACPR communicated a positive opinion to the AMF on OURO CAPITAL SAS’s delisting request.
6. In view of these facts, the Chair of the AMF decided to delist OURO CAPITAL SAS from the list of registered DASP, with immediate effect.
7. OURO CAPITAL SAS informed the AMF that it has permanently ceased its client portfolio management activities and has no remaining clients. Insofar as the company is not subject to the procedure for returning clients' means of access to digital assets referred to in Article D. 54-10-5 of the Monetary and Financial Code, the Chair of the AMF has set the date of deregistration as the date of notification of the AMF's delisting decision.
